## 1. TAYLOR SHELLFISH FARMS

**Address:** 2182 Chuckanut Drive, Bow, WA 98232

**Phone:** 360/766-6002

**Farm type:** Shellfish farm and retail store

**Directions:**

**Heading north on I-5:** Take exit 231. Go northwest on Chuckanut Drive (Hwy 11) for 10 miles to the Oyster Creek Inn. The farm's entrance is in the corner of the Oyster Creek Inn parking lot. Drive under the sign, across the bridge and down the hill. Please use caution: one lane road and railroad crossing.

**Heading south on I-5:** Take exit 250. Go south on Chuckanut Drive to the Oyster Creek Inn. The farm's entrance is in the corner of the Oyster Creek Inn parking lot. Drive under the sign, across the bridge and down the hill. Please use caution: one lane road and railroad crossing.



## 2. GOLDEN GLEN CREAMERY and VIC JENSEN & SONS DAIRY

**Farm type:** Dairy, farmstead cheese, milk bottling operation and retail store

**Directions:** Off of I-5, take exit #231 (Chuckanut Drive), go north on Chuckanut Drive. Travel for approximately 4 miles, traveling through Allen and over the Samish River. Left on Field Road; travel approximately 1 & 1/4 miles. Pass Thomas Road; the Dairy and the Creamery are on the left.



## 3. FRIDAY CREEK FARM

**Address:** 2628 Old Hwy 99 N. Road, Burlington, WA 98233

**Phone:** 360/724-311

**Farm type:** Llama breeding and sales and Boer goat breeding and sales

**Directions:** Off of I-5, take exit #240 (Alger). Turn east at the end of the ramp. Continue east to the first stop sign (Old Hwy 99 North Road). Turn right (south), continue south on Old Hwy 99 North Road for 1 mile. Farm is located on the west side of the street.

## 4 & 5. SAKUMA BROS. FARMS PROCESSING & MARKET STAND

**Market Stand Address:** 17790 Cook Road; Burlington, WA 98233

**Processing Plant Address:** 17400 Cook Road; Burlington, WA 98233

**Market Stand Phone:** 360/757-8004

**Farm type:** Large scale fruit (strawberries, raspberries, blueberries, blackberries & apples) production, commercial processing nursery plants, and Market Stand selling retail fruit, vegetables, gifts and food items.

**Directions:** Off of I-5, take exit 232 (Cook Road/Sedro-Woolley).

Go west off the exit, travel one mile. The Market Stand is on the left, denoted by a large sign. The Processing Plant is located .4 miles west on Cook Road (cross over Chuckanut Drive, plant is on the left).



## 6. DOUBLE O RANCH

**Address:** 46276 Concrete Sauk Valley Road; Concrete, WA 98237

**Phone:** 360/853-8494

**Farm type:** Cattle ranch featuring beef cattle, all natural meat sales (by order only), breeding females, bulls & show steers.

**Directions:** Off of I-5, take exit 232 (Cook Road/Sedro-Woolley). Go east on Cook Road to Sedro-Woolley and turn left at Highway 20 (stop light). Follow Highway 20, traveling east to Concrete. Turn right on Concrete Sauk Valley Road. Go 1 mile, cross bridge and stay left. Go exactly 2 miles, Double O Ranch and Ovenell's Heritage Inn is on the right, see sign.



## 7. CASCADIAN FARM

**Address:** 55931 State Route 20; Rockport, WA 98283

**Phone:** 360/853-8173

**Farm type:** Organic berry farm, pumpkin patch and roadside stand

**Directions:** Off of I-5, take exit 230. Go 40 miles east on Highway 20 to just beyond Milepost 100 (3 miles east of Rockport). Watch for signs and the Cascadian Farm Roadside Stand.



## 8. GLACIER PEAK WINERY

**Address:** 58575 State Route 20, Rockport, WA 98283

**Phone:** 360/873-4073 or 360/770-9811

**Farm type:** Vineyard and wine production

**Directions:** From I-5 take State Route Highway 20 (North Cascade Highway) toward Concrete. Continue on to Rockport. We are located 6 miles east of Rockport. It is approximately 45 miles from I-5.



## 9. LA CONNER FLATS

**Address:** 15920 Best Road, Mount Vernon, WA 98273

**Phone:** 360/466-3190

**Farm type:** A diversified family farm of 230 acres specializing in nursery stock. Potatoes, berries, seed crops, cereals, herbs and cut flowers are also grown. The 11-acre display garden features plants for Northwest Washington and trial vegetables, flowers, roses and cultural methods for success in Skagit Valley.

**Directions:** Heading North on I-5: take exit 221 at Conway, cross over freeway, turn right onto Fir Island Road, which becomes Best Road. Travel 9.5 miles from I-5. we are on the left. Heading South on I-5: take exit 230 at Burlington, head west on Highway 20 for 6 miles, Turn left on Best Road, travel 2 miles, we are on the right.



## 10. ALPACAS OF MISTY RIDGE

**Farm type:** Alpaca breeding/sales/boarding; retail alpaca clothing & gifts, antiques

**Directions:** Heading north on I-5: Take exit #225/Anderson Rd. - go 0.3 miles. Turn left on Anderson Rd. go 0.2 miles and turn right onto Cedardale Rd. Follow Cedardale Road for 3.1 miles. Cedardale is the frontage road running parallel on the east side of I-5. We are located left off the freeway. Look for the colored flags. Heading south on I-5: Take exit #221 toward Lake McMurray/Conway. Go 0.3 miles (take a right off the exit ramp). Turn left on Cedardale Road and go 1.1 miles. Cedardale is the frontage road running parallel on the east side of I-5. We are located right off the freeway. Look for painted "Alpacas" on the side of the barn.



## 11. GORDON SKAGIT FARMS

**Phone:** Retail: 360/424-7262 Wholesale: 360/708-3363

**Farm type:** Wholesale growers and sellers of pumpkins, spinach seed, arugula seed, grass seed, cucumbers, green peas and Jonagold apples. Resale growers of pumpkins, squash, apples, gourds, ornamental corn and heirloom varieties of pumpkins and squash.

**Directions:** Off of I-5, go west on Kincaid Street. Turn right on S. 3rd Street. Go under freeway overpass, stay in the center lane. Go straight through the light at 1st Street and over the Skagit River Bridge. Turn left at the first stop light (Wall Street), which becomes McLean Road. Follow McLean for approximately 3 miles; Gordon Skagit Farms is on the left.



## 12. HEDLIN FAMILY FARM

**Address:** 12275 Valley Road; Mount Vernon, WA 98273

**Phone:** 360/466 3977

**Farm type:** Hedlin Family Farms is a Food Alliance Certified farm that grows 400 acres of a diverse group of Certified Organic and conventional crops including: vegetable seed, pickling cucumbers, wheat and peas and a greenhouse that produces standard beefsteak and heirloom tomatoes as well as transplants for the vegetable industry. In addition, fresh herbs, fruit and flowers are produced for the Hedlin Family Farms fruit stand, farmers markets and local restaurants. As well, Hedlin Family Farms maintains 200 hives of bees for pollination of its seed and cucumber crops.

**Directions:**

**Heading north on I-5:** Take exit 230, head west on Highway 20. Turn left on La Conner-Whitney Road and travel for 4 miles; Hedlin Family Farm is located at the entrance of La Conner, south of the Pioneer monument.

**Heading south on I-5:** Take exit 221 at Conway and follow the signs to La Conner (you will travel approximately 8 miles west). Hedlin Family Farm is located at the entrance of La Conner, south of the Pioneer monument.



### 13. SCHUH FARMS

**Address:** 15565 State Route 536; Mount Vernon, WA 98273

**Phone:** 360/424-6982

**Farm type:** Berry and row crop farm, specializing in berry, corn, cucumber and pumpkin production. Also offers season agri-entertainment & children's activities.

**Directions:** Off of I-5, take exit 226 (Kincaid Street) and go west. Turn right onto S. 3rd Street, stay in the center lane. Go straight through the light at 1st Street and over the Skagit River Bridge onto SR 536. Follow SR 536 for 3 miles; Schuh Farms is on the right.

**Farm type:** Alpaca breeding/boarding/sales; retail alpaca wear, yarn and rovings.

**Directions:** Off of I-5, take Exit 232 (Cook Road/Sedro-Woolley). At stop sign, turn east onto Cook Road. At first light (Old Hwy 99) go straight and follow Cook Road into Sedro-Woolley. At light, turn left onto Hwy 20 (Welcome to Sedro-Woolley sign & train on corner). At next light, turn left onto Hwy 9 (AM/PM & Dairy Queen on corner). Drive north on Hwy 9 for approx. 4 miles; look for sign on the left. Farm is located 4 miles north of Sedro-Woolley on Highway 9 about, 15 minutes from I-5.



### 15. HEMLOCK HIGHLANDS RANCH

**Farm type:** Highland cattle beef and breeding farm

**Directions:** Off of I-5, take the exit 232 (Cook Road/Sedro-Woolley). Go east and travel on Cook Road for approximately 4 miles. Turn left onto Highway 20 and proceed approximately 4 miles to Sims Road, which Y's to the right. Hemlock Highlands is the first building on the right.

**Farm type:** Organic family farm producing Certified Organic grass-fed beef, chicken, pork & eggs. Now in 9th year of organic farming, Skagit River Ranch is committed to produce delicious, chemical free, wholesome food and to practice sustainable agriculture & humane treatment of animals. The farm store is open on Saturdays (10AM to 6PM) year-round. Products are also available at local health food stores, restaurants & farmers markets, check website for details.

**Directions:** Off of I-5, take exit 232 (Cook Road/Sedro-Woolley). Go east to Sedro Woolley. Turn onto Hwy 20, travel for approximately 5 miles. After mile post 70, turn right on Hoehn Road. Go 3/4 miles and turn left on Utopia Road (dead end). 2nd drive way on the right; look for "Open Farm Store" signs. \*\*\*Only 15 minutes from I-5!
